<p><b>AGATHA NONLEY</b> Tennis Instructor</p> <p><i>Optional   Female</i></p>	<p>Agatha Nonley is the notoriously loud tennis instructor at the Shady Oaks Recreation Center. She says exactly what she thinks with zero filter, regardless of who's listening. Agatha is a long-time tennis pro with zero patience for beginners and makes that painfully clear. Though mostly amicable, she has a dangerously short fuse, so avoid anything that might spark a verbal volley.</p>	<p><i>Tennis visor, athletic top, pleated skirt or shorts, tennis racket as a prop.</i></p>

After years of saving, she opened her own business, and the risk paid off. Now the ruthless owner of the Shady Oaks Playhouse Theater, Frieda is a powerhouse. Equal parts rugged and romantic, Hunter surprises most people with his impeccable manners and unexpected charm.</p>	<p><i>Camo shirt or flannel, boots, poetry notebook in pocket, deer antler cap optional.</i></p>
<p><b>MARS BRUNO</b> Lounge Performer</p> <p><i>Optional   Male</i></p>	<p>Mars Bruno is the soulful guitarist and go-to songwriter in Shady Oaks. If you're having a rough day, Mars is the friend who shows up with a guitar and the perfect advice. <b>HUGH HEFFLE</b> Retired Real Estate Magnate  <i>Optional   Male</i>	Hugh Heffle is a high-strung, retired real estate mogul whose mood swings could qualify as natural disasters. One minute he's your fishing buddy; the next, he's yelling about how you abandoned him yesterday (you didn't). Most folks in Shady Oaks approach Hugh with caution—and an escape plan.	<i>Hawaiian shirt, blazer, gold chain, sunglasses, clipboard, or fake real estate flyers.</i>

**\* EXPANDABLE PLAYERS:**

Downloadable versions: The game can be expanded to cover over 100+ players with expandable teams. The downloadable version of the main game has two teams, and the downloadable version of the expansion pack adds a third team. All teams are optional and may add up to 25+ players each.

The characters in each group will play as a team. These non-suspect roles are great for more shy/reserved players, guests who might have a conflict, younger players, or those with a rep for being a no-show on occasion.

If you are using the teams, download the files for each team from your account – two are listed with the files for the main game. They'll be titled: News Crew Team and Police Officer Team. With the expansion pack purchase, you'll get the third team of Tabloid Crew for Starry Magazine with Paul Paratzy.

Make a copy for each player on each team. The team players don't have much of a story besides being their team leader's colleague to add to the game. Their role in the game is to talk about their team leader with others (gossip) and extract information from other characters for their team's use. The teams have a slight advantage since they have multiple players who can talk to everyone and gather information. Once the victim is revealed, they can investigate with their team leader or go solo – it won't matter – it's flexible. The expansion pack (purchased separately) includes 10 more suspect roles and another expandable team. If you want to host a large party, see below.

**\* HOSTING A LARGE PARTY (DOWNLOADABLE VERSION):**

- Main game (purchased separately) – **20** unique suspect roles
  - Expandable team of police officers (**up to 25+** non-suspect, duplicate team roles) – comes with this main game purchase
  - Expandable team of CBC News Crew (**up to 25+** non-suspect, duplicate team roles) – comes with main game purchase
- Expansion pack #1 – **10** unique suspect roles (purchased separately)
  - Expandable team of a tabloid news crew (**up to 25+** non-suspect, duplicate team roles) – comes with expansion pack #1

**Cover 70+ with just the main game purchase (20 suspects, 50+ non-suspect team players), or cover 105+ by also purchasing expansion pack #1 (30 suspects, 75+ non-suspect team members).**

**Boxed versions:**

**Kit A (20 suspects) and Kit B (30 suspects) do not have expandable team players, as we will not include the team players until all 30 suspects are in the game.**
