Contact the guest playing **Fanni-Sid Pyngstad** and say you hope she isn't entered in the House of Groove's dance competition – you don't want her there trying to steal the spotlight from you.

Contact the guest playing **Harry Nadshaw** and say that you don't want to be rude, but you know Harry's leaving roses on your doorstep every day. You are allergic to roses, so you are asking that he please stop.

Contact the guest playing **Barry Vahl** and say that you don't want to be rude, but the pet rock is not really a pet. It's a dumb toy 'invention' – if you can call it an invention.

ROUND ONE CARDS each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

CHARACTER N – ROUND ONE

CLUES TO REVEAL DURING THIS ROUND

- 👁️ You witnessed how talented of a disco dancer that Character I is, and now you want to be his partner in the next disco dancing contest.
- 😡 Talk about your lawsuit against Character G regarding his pet rock invention. Your attorney believes you'll lose the case, and so he called his attorney today to offer a settlement. You are angry about this. You wanted the production of pet rocks to be stopped.
- 👂 Tell Character A he never should have broken up with you in high school when you two dated.

PERSONAL CLUES TO CONCEAL

- 🔍 Question everything that you can. You don't take anything for granted and need to analyze every situation from multiple viewpoints.
- 👂 You are still mad at Characer T for dumping you in high school. He dumped you for his ex-wife (Character B's sister). You're embarrassed that you ever loved a loser like him.
- 👂 You are suing Character G for making the pet rock on behalf of the American public. You think he is swindling people out of money.
- 👂 Character R makes you sick! You can't believe he is here too. What are the odds that two men that dumped you would both be here tonight?

ROUND TWO CARDS each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

CHARACTER C - ROUND TWO

**OH NO! THE FUZZ ARE ON THEIR WAY,
HERE'S THE SKINNY - CHARACTER K WAS
JUST FOUND DEAD ON THE DANCE FLOOR!**

The question is...what happened to Character K? Was this an accident? Question the other cats in the room to see what possible motive they might have had to get rid of Character K.

CLUES:

- ☠ Question Character T about where she was during the murder. You don't recall seeing her on the dance floor when the victim died.
- ☠ Could poison be a likely cause of death? Was Character K drinking anything right before they died?
- ☠ Character Y was dancing next to Character E when everyone was freestyle disco dancing. But was she anywhere near Character K?
- ☠ On the dance floor, you were on the other side of Character Q, but not right next to Character K when they died.
- ☠ Could the orientation of the *****removed**** mean anything?
- ☠ When the contest first started, Character S was dancing. However, she had a weird look on her face and was staring at Character K.

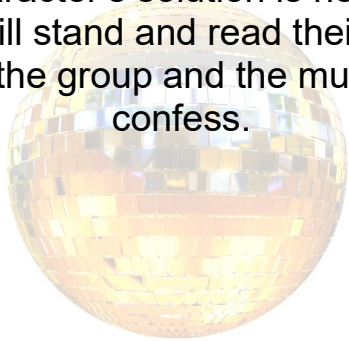
ROUND 3 SOLUTION CARDS – there will be one for each player.

And there is a game solution file that you can open after the mystery is resolved if there are any lingering questions.

This file is representative of the download version. The party pack version of this game will be prepared on double-sided; parchment style paper and all clue cards are foldable and will be slipped (in the party ready version) into graphically labeled envelopes. It's not something that can be accomplished at home with the DIY download version.

The nametags will be on adhesive backed paper and the victim's sign will be placed into a graphically labeled envelope.

The host instructions are within a professionally printed/bound booklet, and the investigation cards are double sided and professionally printed on a cardstock.

Note: this game does not contain a forensic report, but will have an optional murder weapon cut-out.
