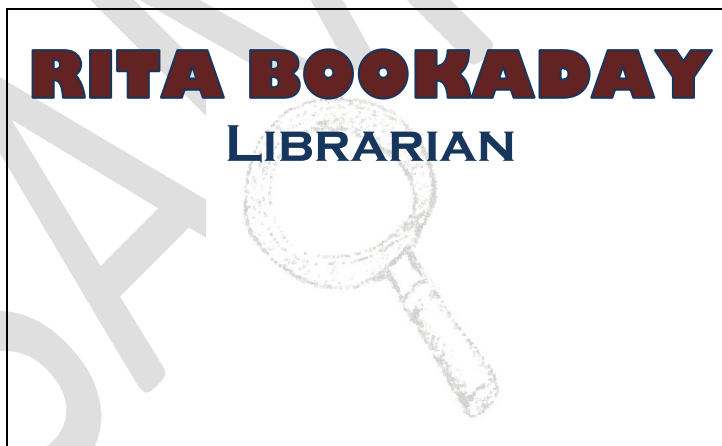

CLUES TO REVEAL:

- 🔍 You heard a rumor that Character Y paid off Character L to change the zoning so that Character V cannot build a resort that overlooks their private golf course.
- 🔍 You should try to pick up some new clients at this party. Ask around to see if there are any potential clients that you could represent. You don't care what it is as long as it pays.

CLUES TO CONCEAL:

- ☠️ You are an obvious *ambulance chaser* and a compulsive liar with 0% integrity – so have fun playing this role.
- ☠️ Character T fired you as her defense attorney last week. You were getting a lot of media attention from her because she is a spoiled celebrity who can't stay out of trouble. You have had all charges against her thus far dropped but the last one (a DWI) was not dropped, so she fired you. That's not fair. The judge &/or district attorney must have either been paid off or pressured from the townspeople not to drop the charges.
- 🖋️ You just started dating an investigative field reporter for CBC news - Character S.

ROUND TWO CARDS each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

CHARACTER K - ROUND TWO

PRE-MURDER:

- You just remembered that Character G and Character T are related, but you can't remember exactly how.
- It is driving you *batty* trying to discern the reason for this guest list and why the owners are anonymous. Ask around and try to figure out who they are!
- Why do you think Character V hates Character L so much? You should find out why.

POST-MURDER:

- Clues removed to prevent spoilers, but there will be
- ~ 3-5 clues per character card.
- They will mingle about and share these after the murder occurs.

ROUND 3 SOLUTION CARDS – there will be one for each player.

And there is a game solution file that you can open after the mystery is resolved if there are any lingering questions.

This file is representative of the download version. The party pack version of this game will be prepared on double-sided; parchment style paper and all clue cards are foldable and will be slipped (in the party ready version) into graphically labeled envelopes. It's not something that can be accomplished at home with the DIY download version.

The nametags will be on adhesive backed paper and the victim's sign will be placed into a graphically labeled envelope. Given the storyline, there is not a forensic report with this game.

The riddles will be printed for you, and the note for Professor Newton will be in her envelope – whether you have us stuff your envelopes for rounds 1-3 or not.

The host instructions are within a professionally printed/bound booklet, and the investigation cards are double sided and professionally printed on a cardstock.
