Contact the guest playing Flossy G. and say the following: your days are numbered at the circus! I've been searching online for a new lead trapeze artist. As soon as I find one, I'll notify Max of your replacement.

CONTACT INFO:

Contact the guest playing Bat Von Tats and say the following: I don't like you loitering in front of the wax museum. I prefer to keep the entrance clear for customers.

CONTACT INFO:

Contact the guest playing Skywheel Danny and say the following: you should clean the bounce house with disinfectants each day. It smells foul in there!

CONTACT INFO:

ROUND ONE CARDS each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

CHARACTER G- ROUND ONE

DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING WITH OTHERS:

- ✍️ Talk about *The Mirror of Behāwian*. It is a full-length mirror with an ornate mastodon bone frame. In the 1600s, seven powerful oracles were executed after being accused of using sorcery, and their ashes were placed behind the mirror. The mirror was sealed by using the never-ending fire in the Cave of Sibyl in the Appalachian Mountains. It has been passed down for generations in your family. It sees the inner being and desires of any person who looks into it. Many people who work for the funfair have peered into their reflection and have seen horrible things. Character I is a demon, Character Q is nothing but a ball of chaotic anger who wants to tear others down, and Character B is a murderer – only to name a few. Everyone who works for the funfair should be afraid of their colleagues. There is far too much evil here.
- ✍️ Talk about how you met Character W at your fortune-telling shop in New Orleans. You were being stalked by a serial killer and had seen your death in the crystal ball. They intervened in your fate and recruited you to this funfair.

PERSONAL INFORMATION:

- ✍️ You are worried about most of your colleagues. Many have evil souls and are murderers and thieves.

ROUND TWO CARDS each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

CHARACTER D – ROUND TWO

DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING BEFORE THE MURDER:

- ☠ Convince others that you will be a headlining act one day when you get the sword swallowing and fire tricks down. You've been practicing for months. It's disheartening, however, that you have begged CHARACTER E for support and encouragement, but CHARACTER E only talks about how they are the main attraction, and nobody will ever come close to being as talented. They are a narcissist – as well as the rest of the performers in the Big Top show. You are tired of their condescending attitudes! You are tired of them looking down upon the supporting staff!
- ☠ If you found out that anyone here had a reward for their capture, you would turn them in. You'd love to get reward money so you can retire in a mountain cabin and live the rest of your days in peace.

POST-MURDER FACTS TO DISCUSS:

- ☠ Here is the evidence for the case.
- ☠ Each player will have 3-5 points of evidence.
- ☠ They will use this for the investigation.

This file is representative of the download version. The party pack version of this game will be prepared on double-sided; parchment style paper and all clue cards are foldable and will be slipped (in the party ready version) into graphically labeled envelopes. It's not something that can be accomplished at home with the DIY download version.

The nametags will be on adhesive backed paper and the victim's sign and forensic report will be placed into graphically labeled envelopes. The host instructions are within a professionally printed/bound booklet, and the investigation cards are double sided and professionally printed on a cardstock.
