PRE-GAME ROUND

Contact the following guests at any time before the murder mystery party. In the story's timeline, this is before Roland Kingsley was murdered:

Contact Bobby Underhill and say you find it funny that ever since you signed Pat Kingsley to *Kingsley Records*, Pat hasn't spent any time with Roland. Their marriage is doomed, and you couldn't be happier.

Contact Grayson Green and say you heard Grayson was served lawsuit papers for defamation by Roland Kingsley (your brother). However, you thought members of the press were protected by The First Amendment? How can someone sue for what is reported on the news? Roland is a hypocrite and a terrible person inside and out.

ROUND ONE CARDS each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

CHARACTER B

CLUES TO REVEAL TO OTHERS:

- You have been collecting mastodon bones for over a decade. You have over half of a skeleton thus far. You wish to fully articulate it, cover it in 24-K gold, and display the skeleton in your foyer of your California mansion. You have outrageous parties with celebs and wish to impress. You have been searching for pieces of the hind limbs, but have been unsuccessful thus far.
- You are angry with Character I, as you believe s/he's a filthy traitor. S/he had promised to find you more mastodon bones. You said you'd pay top dollar, so s/he set up an archaeological site in San Diego. Character I found a femur, estimated to be over 115K years old. S/he gave it to Roland Kingsley, who just started collecting mastodon bones – only because you want them!

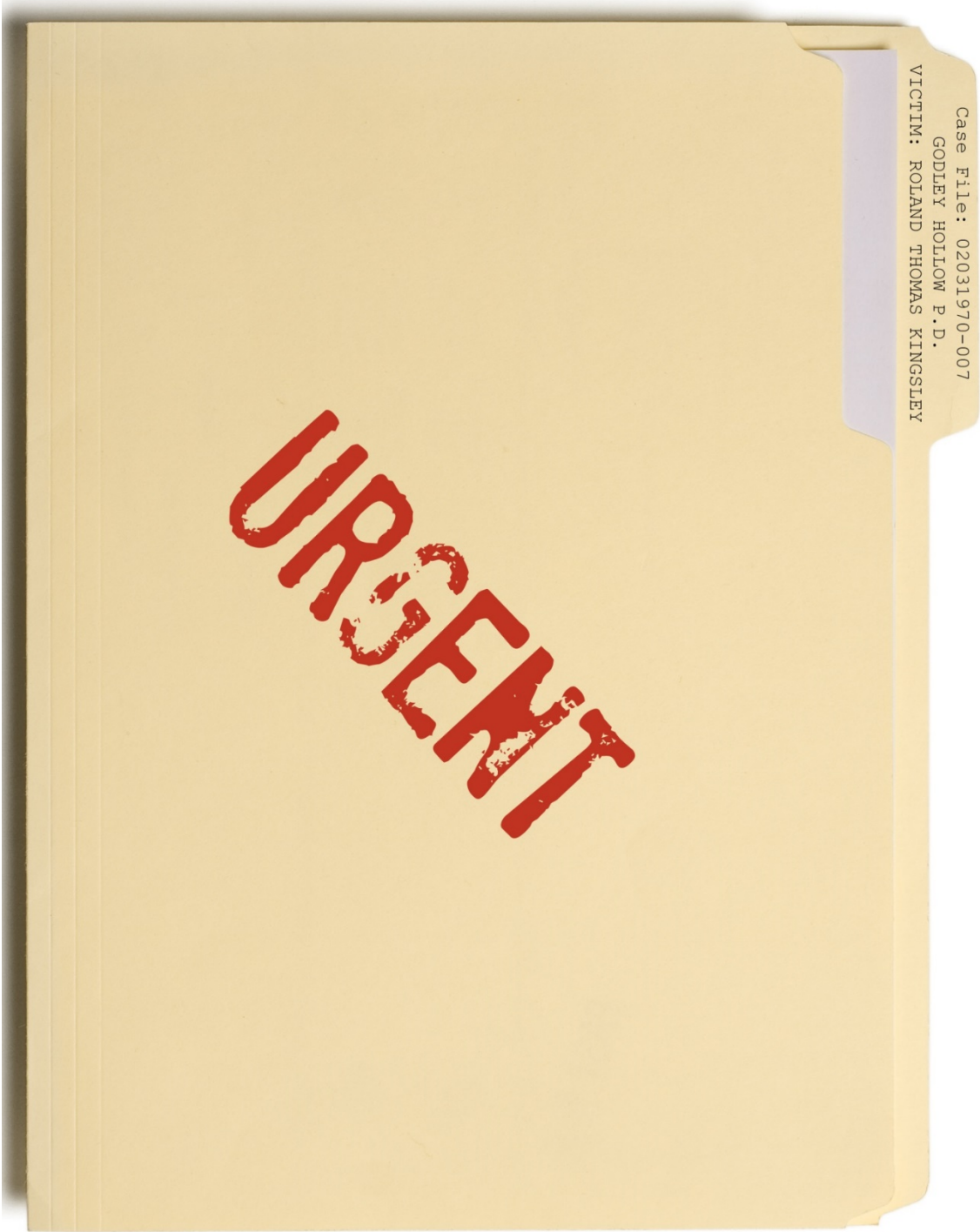
CLUES YOU MAY CONCEAL:

- You spoke to your brother (Roland) the week before he died. It was a heated conversation about how Character N had promised to find you a mastodon femur for your collection, which s/he did, but Roland hired s/he as a personal bone/fossil collector. Therefore, s/he gave the bone to Roland. You were furious.
- Your brother called you on the Wednesday prior

to his death to gloat about how he had acquired the mastodon femur. Once you found out that Roland had hired Character I as a personal bone collector, you hung up the phone without saying goodbye.

- Character K doesn't speak fondly of Roland Kingsley. You believe Character K only married Roland to get in the family so you'd sign Character K to *Kingsley Records*. You don't blame Character K – their plan was working until Roland died. Character K's broke and will need another hit single ASAP!
- You have a rare genetic disease called cytopheria. Your brother also had it, and so did your father. You are taking an experimental drug called GENZ-X-006 and are under the care of Dr. Peyton Payne. Dr. Payne was also giving the drug to Roland. So far, the drug isn't working, but you aren't having any bad symptoms other than enlarged kidneys.
- You have an extensive garden and many greenhouses. You grow exotic plants, including poisonous varieties. You never lock your back gate or your greenhouse because you have staff that maintains the grounds. You grow *Abrus precatorius* and originally purchased the seeds online – just like you did for the other plants.

This file is representative of the download version. The party pack version of this game will be prepared on double-sided; parchment style paper and all clue cards are foldable and will be slipped (in the party ready version) into graphically labeled envelopes. It's not something that can be accomplished at home with the DIY download version.

The nametags will be on adhesive backed paper. The case files are inserted into manilla file folders and appropriately labeled with the case.

The host instructions are within a professionally printed/bound booklet, and the investigation cards are double sided and professionally printed on a cardstock.
