## **PARSON GOLDEN**

**Pre-game tasks: contact the following players before the party:**

**Respond to the** guest playing Jude Plum and say that it is true that you recently purchased a speed boat. However, your fashion line isn't doing as well as you expected, so you would like to talk to Jude at Darby's luau party to see if she can help you promote it. *(If Jude doesn't contact you, disregard this task.)*

**Contact** the guest playing Piper White and say that you would appreciate it if Piper would give you the executive producer's contact information for the film s/he is currently working on. You would like to start designing costumes for films. You've got to start at the bottom (no offense) and work your way up to the big budget films.

**CONTACT INFO:**

**Contact** the guest playing Ren Peach and say that you recently got hooked on the soap opera, *Gorgeous Thieves*. You can't believe that Ren plays such an evil character, as s/he wasn't evil when s/he was a reality television star!

**CONTACT INFO:**

**ROUND ONE CARDS** each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

### **character Y – ROUND ONE**

Mingle with others to discuss the following information:

- 🦋 Talk to \*name removed\* about how much you cannot stand \*name removed\*. You don't think you are going to perform in town ever again after what \*name removed\* did to you. \*name removed\* came to your show, sat in the front row, and heckled you the entire time. You finally were fed up and started a fight with \*name removed\* and had to cancel the rest of the show and refund everybody's tickets.
- 🦋 Talk to \*name removed\* about how his/her fashion line is doing. You know \*name removed\* has a boutique and web store, so when is the big \*name removed\* fashion line getting into the department stores?
- 🦋 Ask \*name removed\* why s/he bought the *Sun City Amusement Park* and fired all the upper-level management and maintenance staff.




#### **PERSONAL CLUES TO CONCEAL**

- 🦋 You had a severe backlash on social media about canceling your comedy performance midway through. However, you were so angry with \*name removed\* for harassing you, that you couldn't continue. You two got into a fight, and you ended up with a bloody nose. There are videos and pictures all over the internet of this incident. You think this might give other hecklers ideas that they can get this much attention if they heckle you - because you had a copycat heckler that later did the same thing as \*name removed\*. This could snowball into a *career ender*.
- 🦋 If you brought any jokes with you, feel free to try out your material on the other guests.

**ROUND TWO CARDS** each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

### character W – ROUND TWO

#### PRE-MURDER CLUES TO DISCUSS:

-  Tell others that \*name removed\* is a snake. \*Name removed\* has never gotten along with you and lied and said that his/her boss gave her the story to investigate about the quality of meat in your butcher shop. \*Name removed\* is doing this on purpose to try to ruin you because s/he hasn't liked you since high school. Ask others to tell \*name removed\* that the meat at your shop is the best in town! The ratings will plummet on the midday newscast if s/he even thinks about doing a story on the quality of your meat at your butcher shop – you will see to it!
-  Tell everybody that \*name removed\* doesn't tip service people and does whatever s/he can to get free stuff.
-  Ask \*name removed\* about how the amusement park is doing. You heard \*name removed\* bought one.

#### POST MURDER CLUES TO DISCUSS:

- Clues removed to prevent spoilers, but there will be
- ~ 3-5 clues per character card.
- They will mingle about and share these after the murder occurs.
