#17: REQUIRED	ROOSTER HICKENBUTTS Farmhand	<p>Trailer Park: Fall Pines, Lot 3 Birthday: June 23rd</p> <p>You'll always remember meeting Rooster Hickenbutts, as this farmhand must always restate the last word spoken in a conversation at a loud volume. Rooster works at the Chickenwort Pig Farm on the outskirts of town and can be very defensive if you say anything untoward about Bubbles Chickenwort.</p> <p>It can be challenging to convince Rooster of anything, so dealing with Rooster on any level can take time and effort. In addition, Rooster takes tiny baby sips and bites, so eating a meal with this farmhand also takes double the time commitment. Roosters also strives to stay well-rested, so daily cat naps are routine.</p>	<p>Wear overalls and a plaid flannel button-up shirt. Or be festive and wear a pig costume or pig ears and a tail. Mullet wig or style your hair as a mullet.</p>	<p>This role should be played by an outgoing personality who likes to be silly.</p> <p>This person must be a firm RSVP.</p>
#18: REQUIRED	P.J. POOTIE Radio DJ	<p>Trailer Park: Summer Gardens, Lot 21 Birthday: June 12th</p> <p>The smooth, melodic voice of P.J. Pootie is blasted out daily on the local WBC Radio station of Henpecked Junction from the first rooster crows until lunchtime. The P.J. Morning Show discusses town drama, gives incorrect weather predictions, and occasionally spills sweet tea on juicy celebrity gossip.</p> <p>P.J. always takes in stray animals, leading to trouble at the trailer park. This morning show host prefers the dark and is exceptionally easy to influence - which is excellent if you need someone to take your side. However, P.J. always pulls for the underdog, so there's that. This disc jockey can get squirmy if seated too long, so don't invite P.J. to a long, drawn-out seated dinner.</p>	<p>Any music-inspired t-shirt and jeans or jorts (jean shorts) with a mullet wig or style your hair into a mullet.</p>	<p>This role should be played by an outgoing personality.</p> <p>This person must be a firm RSVP.</p>
#19: REQUIRED	FIGS SPITHOUSE Car Lot Mascot	<p>Trailer Park: Fall Pines, Lot 11 Birthday: May 29th</p> <p>The eye-rolling car lot mascot named Figs Spithouse must always start a conversation about food. A self-proclaimed foodie, Figs aspires to become an award-winning chef. Figs aspires to try out for all reality television cooking shows but must learn how to cook first. Figs has never been injured but walks with a limp. Some say this is for attention, and others claim that Figs just learned to walk that way. Even with all the food obsession, Figs has terrible etiquette and is a messy eater, so if you dine with Figs, sit a couple of seats away. Figs also does a weird pause before speaking – so head's up on that thing.</p>	<p>Any mascot costume you wish. Mullet wig if your head is not covered by a headpiece.</p>	<p>This role should be played by a more class-clown personality.</p> <p>This person must be a firm RSVP.</p>

#20: REQUIRED	<p>WEE-WEE WILLYWEED</p> <p>Roadie, Kid Cooter Band</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Fall Pines, Lot 5 Birthday: May 1st</p> <p>Wee-Wee Willyweed is the head roadie for the Kid Cooter Band. Wee-Wee boasts about being with the band and carries a spoon named Spoonie. Wee-Wee makes Spoonie talk to people as it bounces in the air. Maybe it's due to the influence of being around musicians but Wee-Wee loves to make up rhymes about situations. Sometimes this can be rude, but it is always quite hilarious. Wee-Wee always wears a cowboy hat but has never ridden a horse or stepped foot on a farm or ranch. Nevertheless, Wee-Wee likes their appearance and is obsessed with the cowboy lifestyle and couture.</p>	<p>Western attire of any kind with a mullet wig or style your hair into a mullet.</p>	<p>This character should go to a more outgoing personality who likes to be weird/silly. This person must be a firm RSVP.</p>

#21: OPTIONAL	<p>BILLA-BOBBY BOONE</p> <p>Painter</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Winter Hills, Lot 15 Birthday: February 16th</p> <p>Billa-Bobby Boone is an overly clumsy and shy painter. Billa-Bobby is one of the only painters-for-hire in Henpecked Junction, so Billa has essentially <i>painted the town</i>. Billa-Bobby wears oversized clothing, and some say it's to intimidate others by increasing the illusion of their size. Nobody can make sense of this line of thinking, but they just let Billa-Bobby be Billa Bobby. This paintbrush wielder is a one-upper who often stands in a sassy position with one hand on their hip.</p>	<p>Wear coveralls with paint splatters on them. Have an optional paint brush and palette as props. Mullet wig or style your hair into a mullet.</p>	<p>This role may be played by any personality type.</p>
#22: OPTIONAL	<p>ANGEL FARTZ</p> <p>Golf Ball Diver</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Fall Pines, Lot 12 Birthday: June 29th</p> <p>If you can hear nails clicking against a surface, you'll likely come up on Angel Fartz. Angel cannot stop tapping their fingernails on surfaces, so those close to this golf ball diver will clip them to the nailbeds so everyone can have peace. Angel is known for colossal hand gestures to emphasize points and must always plan every detail to the minute. Yet, Angel is tenderhearted, which is an excellent foundation for friendships. Angel stretches like they are about to exercise but never goes to the gym or even works out. Angel dives into the ponds at the golf ranges, collecting golf balls to sell on an Eggsy site called <i>Not New Golf Balls</i>.</p>	<p>Either a scuba diving costume or golfing attire, as you're trying to fit in. Mullet wig or style your hair as a mullet.</p>	<p>This role may be played by any personality type.</p>
#23: OPTIONAL	<p>BLUE RIBBON</p> <p>Paper Towel Sniffer</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Summer Gardens, Lot 12 Birthday: June 2nd</p> <p>Blue Ribbon is a flashback to the 1960s from head to toe. Blue wasn't even born in the '60s, but says we should all live in that decade, nevertheless, and wishes everyone would at least return to the fashion. Blue works as a professional sniffer in the Q.C. department at a paper towel factory adjacent to Henpecked Junction. Blue believes in UFOs and intergalactic aliens and has started a Don't Get Probed club that tracks sightings and abductions. Blue is awkward as they constantly move while talking and look downward at the ground.</p>	<p>1960s-inspired attire of any kind. Mullet wig or style your hair into a '60s-inspired mullet (tease it and then spray it smooth).</p>	<p>This role may be played by any personality type.</p>

#24: OPTIONAL	<p>TOOTS BURGER</p> <p>Nurse</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Summer Gardens, Lot 5 Birthday: July 6th</p> <p>Toots Burger is a snorting chuckler with the most contagious fit of laughter – everyone in the room will join in – even when they don't know what they are laughing about. Toots loves to argue for any reason and can't touch another person without cringing. Toots must point at the person they are speaking to, which confuses conversations – especially when you are one of Toots' patients at the clinic. Toots is never satisfied with the room temperature and continually asks whoever controls the thermostat to change the temperature up and down.</p>	<p>Nurse attire - scrubs with an optional stethoscope as a prop or you can wear the traditional nurse's costume for a female. Mullet wig.</p>	<p>This role may be played by any personality type.</p>
#25: OPTIONAL	<p>TEEGAN TINYFACE</p> <p>Beverage Pong Emcee</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Spring Meadows, Lot 10 Birthday: August 3rd</p> <p>Teegan Tinyface is the Beverage Pong Tourney Emcee from Henpecked Junction. Teegan travels to various regional competitions as the gracious host, judge, and moderator of the exciting beverage pong qualifiers. Teegan often wears tiny clothing, believing it is slimming to stuff into shirts and pants like sausage. Teegs couldn't tell a lie to save their life, so this is a problem when this emcee is asked for honesty because sometimes, the truth is brutal to hear. Teegan is an air-quoter who is overly cautious about who they allow into their inner circle of friends.</p>	<p>Cheesy leisure suit and a mullet wig or style your hair into a meticulous mullet.</p>	<p>Choose a more energetic, outgoing person for this character role.</p>
#26: OPTIONAL	<p>JACKIE WIMPLESNATCH</p> <p>Telemarketer</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Spring Meadows, Lot 2 Birthday: October 8th</p> <p>Jackie Wimplesnatch is always late because of a total lack of a sense of direction. Even with the maps on smartphones shouting out explicit orders, Jackie can't follow them and arrive anywhere on time. So if you invite Jackie somewhere, put the time starting at least an hour earlier so that Jackie's on time. Jackie is a charming telemarketer known for making snap decisions and wearing unmatched attire. In addition, Jackie, an extremely delicate eater, treats food like an equal, thanking the food for every bite. Jackie often causes bouts of laughter as they grunt when the room grows silent to break the tension.</p>	<p>Casual Mullet Fest attire with a headset and mullet wig or styled hair into a mullet.</p>	<p>This role may be played by any personality type.</p>
#27: OPTIONAL	<p>GREASY GRIMES</p> <p>Portable Toilet Manager</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Winter Hills, Lot 5 Birthday: November 30th</p> <p>Greasy Grimes is the portable toilet manager for <i>Easy Brown Portable Potties</i>. Greasy walks with giant steps as if they are still stuck in a game of <i>Mother May I</i> from grade school. If that's not strange enough, Greasy will hum when not speaking and cannot stop obsessing about their hair. Then, as if that's insufficient to make you go hmm, Greasy will pretend to be typing their words. Greasy is one of the most prominent personalities in Henpecked Junction – that's for sure.</p>	<p>Coveralls with 'Easy Brown Portable Potties' nametag (you can DIY one). Mullet wig or style your hair as a mullet.</p>	<p>This role may be played by any personality type.</p>

#28: OPTIONAL	<p>LIL LOU BUTTERBEAN</p> <p>Crime Scene Cleaner</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Spring Meadows, Lot 31 Birthday: December 10th</p> <p>Lil Lou Butterbean has one of the most challenging state jobs ever created. Lou's a crime scene clean-up technician. So if somebody gets murdered in your living room, Lil Lou's team will clean it all up and make it look spanking new to you. Albeit, if you believe in ghosts, they can't do anything about that.</p> <p>Lou has an irrational fear of red food and will start to squeal if anything red touches a dinner plate. Lou's an absolute control freak about any situation, so it's good that Lou is the team leader of the crime scene clean-up crew. Lou scratches their exposed skin like 1,000 mosquito bites and claims to be allergic to air. So Lou usually wears long sleeves and pants. Lil Lou occasionally changes their accent to appear intelligent – but those who know Lou well say that Lou can only speak English.</p>	<p>Lab coat with biohazard symbol or a hazmat suit. #29: OPTIONAL	<p>SQUID SCUTTLEBUTZ</p> <p>Restroom Attendant</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Winter Hills, Lot 21 Birthday: November 16th</p> <p>Squid Scuttlebutz is the restroom attendant at the Spotted Stag Dance Hall. Squid swings their arms so largely while walking that everyone needs to give this mint slinger plenty of space. Squid is notoriously early to any event and is a pathological liar. Even when the truth is best for a situation, Squid can't seem to allow their lips to form truthful words. However, Squid is an extraordinarily talented artist and actor. Squid sells oil paintings every Saturday at the swap meets and has always landed leading roles in the local theater's plays.</p>	<p>Business casual attire with a mullet wig or style your hair into a mullet. You can have mouthwash, cologne, and mints as optional props to offer to others for a price.</p>	<p>This character should go to a more outgoing personality with moderate acting skills.</p>
#30: OPTIONAL	<p>CASH CARLETON</p> <p>Owner, Studio 5, 6, 7, 8</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Summer Gardens, Lot 6 Birthday: June 15th</p> <p>Cash Carleton is the extremely busy owner of the local dance studio, Studio 5, 6, 7, 8. Cash is known for wearing obnoxious hats that don't even match their clothing. In addition, Cash has a bizarre fear of fruits and veggies and refuses to go near them. Nobody knows what this irrational fear stems from, but it can be unpleasant if you meet up for dinner. Cash is obsessed with counting things, even if it's utterly irrelevant. Cash has landed a full hour at Mullet Fest for Studio 5, 6, 7, 8 dancers to perform. Many say Cash handed someone cash for this stage time.</p>	<p>Athletic attire-workout suit, or even a glitzy dance costume, as your studio is performing on the main stage. Mullet wig or style your hair as a mullet.</p>	<p>This role may be played by any personality type.</p>
#31: OPTIONAL	<p>HUNTER SQUATPUMP</p> <p>Fry Cook</p>	<p>Trailer Park: Winter Hills, Lot 6 Birthday: March 4th</p> <p>Hunter Squatpump is a boisterous fry cook at the Angry Rooster – a fried chicken fast-food restaurant. Hunter is particularly good at frying things, and the owner of Flo's Fry Palace hired Hunter for the Mullet Fest booth as the lead fry cook for the day. Hunter always wears sunglasses – even in the dark, and compulsively arranges items within reach.</p> <p>Everyone at Angry Rooster loves to work with this fry cook. Hunter entertains by doing cartwheels and handstands whenever and wherever possible. Hunter also makes up funny cheers to fit what's happening around them.</p>	<p>Chef's costume or any fast-food uniform. Create an 'Angry Rooster' nametag as an optional prop. #32: OPTIONAL	<p>Q BODYCOMB</p> <p>Tattoo Artist</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Trailer Park: Spring Meadows, Lot 4 Birthday: July 2nd</p> <p>Q is a talented tattoo artist at the <i>Henpecked Tattoo Parlor</i>. This year at Mullet Fest, Q is fully booked for the day in the Tatts and Tiaras booth. Q is quite a character as they speak to inanimate objects as if they are alive – even responding to the objects' replies as if having a real conversation. This certainly takes the clients' minds off the needles pummeling ink into their skin. Q will switch between singing words and speaking normally, which is also an excellent distraction for Q's clients.</p>	<p>Casual attire. If you don't have tattoos - costume sleeve tattoos. Adhere facial piercings with spirit gum (optional). Mullet wig.</p>	<p>This character should go to a more outgoing personality. They should have a fun personality.</p>
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
