Pre-game tasks

OPTIONAL - for some pre-party fun, contact the following guests in the week leading up to the party:

RESPOND to the guest playing **Adair Burgundy** and say that you don't have to answer to anybody about the letters you write, and you will not discuss it further with Adair at the Cosmo Casino.

Contact the guest playing **Cricket Pewter** and say that you are growing very tired of Cricket trying to chase you around Las Vegas to get a juicy story. Cricket better watch his/her step, as your entourage is known to smash people's knees that bother you – and you have no power to stop them.

Contact the guest playing **Rigny Cyan** and say it was unfortunate that someone sitting in the front row threw soda all over Rigny during his/her performance. Tough luck!

ROUND ONE CARDS each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

CHARACTER J – ROUND ONE

CLUES TO REVEAL DURING THIS ROUND

- ☞ You have to work out at the gym twice a day to keep up appearances for your character on the soap opera *Gorgeous Thieves*. You are also on a spinach and blueberry diet – that is all you eat and thus far, you're feeling okay.
- ☞ Ask around to see what others think about the Sin City Slayer. Do other guests believe the slayer will strike tonight? You have done a ton of research, and in your opinion, you believe the slayer is Character N.
- ☞ You auditioned for the starring role in *Ice Cold Fangs*, and Character E won the role. You were furious, as that was to be your big break onto the big screen and that is what catapulted them into uber-fame. Character E was an established Hollywood figure, but that movie really made them an icon. You heard from your agent that you are up for the starring role in the *Great Pumpkin Patch Heist* movie as the lead pumpkin - and so is Character E. You are enraged! Character E will get the role!

PERSONAL CLUES TO CONCEAL

- ☞ You are the top Hollywood Icon because you were a famous reality television personality, and now you are a soap opera star on the show *Gorgeous Thieves*. Your face is everywhere – on magazines, commercials, billboards, etc.
- ☞ You despise other celebrities!

ROUND TWO CARDS each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

CHARACTER NAME REMOVED - ROUND TWO

Pre-Murder Clues

- Admit you do supplement your income by stealing things out of people's bags that you hold while they ride the rides in the amusement park. In your opinion, the customers of the amusement park shouldn't bring things with them that you have to watch over in the cubby holes while they have fun riding the ride. There is a sign above the cubby holes that *the hotel and the amusement park are not responsible for lost or stolen items*. The riders ignore the warning, so you don't feel bad about taking their things!
- Character S reported you to the manager for stealing his/her wallet. They are viewing the camera footage, and you will go to jail because there was a ton of money in their wallet and there are cameras recording the loading/unloading section of the rides. You steal all of the time, but the riders never know to report you, as they've been at the amusement park and casino and can't place where they lost their stuff. You've been asked by one rider before about their missing items, and you just pointed to the sign and said there is nothing that you can do about it. You are very angry at Character S.

Post-Murder Evidence (Blood Type O+)

- Clues removed to prevent spoilers, but there will be ~ 3-5 clues per character card.
- They will mingle about and share these after the murder occurs.

ROUND 3 SOLUTION CARDS – there will be one for each player.

CHARACTER T - FINAL SOLUTION

READ AFTER character H

When it is your turn, say the following to the group:

This character will have a solution written here that they present to the group. They all take turns and ultimately, the murderer will confess.

CHARACTER R IS NEXT

In the printables file, there are 18 pages will be mystery investigation sheets that have a diagram of the event space – that you are not to recreate – just keep it in the storyline.

And there is a game solution file that you can open after the mystery is resolved if there are any lingering questions.

This file is representative of the download version. The party pack version of this game will be prepared on double-sided; parchment style paper and all clue cards are foldable and will be slipped (in the party ready version) into graphically labeled envelopes. It's not something that can be accomplished at home with the DIY download version.

The nametags will be on adhesive backed paper and the victim's sign and forensic report will be placed into graphically labeled envelopes. The host instructions are within a professionally printed/bound booklet, and the investigation cards are double sided and professionally printed on a cardstock.
