



HOST CHARACTER LIST – EXPANSION #1

CHARACTERS #19-30 (BOXED VERSION KIT B)

12 optional players, all gender flexible. These optional players may be played in any number or combination with optional characters from the main game and expansion pack #1.

Download version: We highly advise you to play the expansion packs in order, but you do not need to play all the characters in this pack before purchasing expansion pack #2. The characters are added to the lists in order as they occur (pre-game site, invitation, and guest list for the game). Therefore, if you skipped expansion pack #1 and only purchased expansion pack #2 – you’d still have expansion pack #1 characters listed on your pre-game site, invitation, and guest list that you’d use for reference at the party, but you wouldn’t have materials for those characters, so they would not be assigned.

One character in this pack (Reagan Paratsy) is expandable. The expandable team file comes with the download version, and you will make a copy for each player on the team.

Boxed version (Party Pack): These unique suspect characters #19-30 are included with Kits B-F. The expandable team (Tabloid Crew) is included with Kits D-F.

If Kelly doesn’t make it big in Hollywood – it will be someone else’s fault, as this drama conjurer is remarkably quick to point the blame at anyone for anything.</p>	<p>Trendy, glamorous attire. Optional prop is a marker and slips of paper to give autographs to the other guests.</p>
<p>HARPER VANCE Assassin for Hire</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>Hailing from Las Vegas, Harper Vance is an elusive hired gun from New York. Harper admits the choice of profession but claims there has never been any evidence against Harper for a crime. It’s best not to question this assassin, and you should always watch your back.</p>	<p>Black suit, toy guns in every pocket / strapped to you in every location. Optional to make business cards for your assassin business to pass out during the party.</p>
<p>DYLAN MCBREEZEN Videographer</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>Dylan McBreezen is a melancholy videographer. Why this doom-and-gloomer would choose a career to film people enjoying themselves is beyond anyone’s comprehension. However, this gothic videographer’s dark and quirky event videos are becoming quite the Las Vegas trend.</p>	<p>All black, casual attire. Optional to make business cards to pass out during the party.</p>
<p>TERRY CANE Comedian</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>Details, details, details—if you’re speaking to Terry Cane, you had better get ready for a plethora of intricate points and facts! This overexplaining comedian will jump at the chance to perform an impromptu standup comedy routine. Terry hosts a show on Comedy Center named <i>Terry-O</i>, which has over 10 million viewers each week.</p>	<p>Comical T-shirt and jeans. Bring some jokes with you to the party!</p>

<p>JUSTICE CROSS Restaurant Manager, Cosmo Resort & Casino</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>Justice Cross is the self-centered restaurant manager of the <i>BeBe Steakhouse</i> in the Cosmo Resort & Casino. Justice is constantly perspiring and smoking a Sherlock Holmes-style pipe. Justice is eccentric and blames everything on ghosts.</p>	<p>Casual attire. A Sherlock Holmes-style pipe, a plastic baggie with water, and a sponge are optional props to keep you 'sweaty.'</p>
<p>MAYOR PAULI TISHON Mayor of Las Vegas</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>There are two sides to Mayor Pauli Tishon, and one of them should be avoided at all costs! If you have something to offer, the mayor has your back. However, if you double-cross Pauli, you will be filled with regret. Those working in the mayor's office have learned to evade Pauli on a bad day!</p>	<p>Formal business attire.</p>
<p>CAMPBELL SANCHEZ Defense Attorney</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>'Liar, liar, pants on fire' is a phrase that encapsulates Campbell Sanchez, Esquire. If freedom is your desire, you'll want this obnoxious criminal defense attorney on your side of the courtroom, even if you are guilty of murder! Campbell makes ambulance chasers look like Peace Corps volunteers!</p>	<p>Trendy and fashionable attire.</p>
<p>REAGAN PARATZY Trash Tabloid Reporter</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>Reagan Paratzy is the tenacious trash tabloid reporter known as 'Gutter Press Royalty!' If there is an impossible story to scoop – Reagan always manages to get the right photos and exclusive interviews with insiders. There is nothing this journalist won't do to get the story!</p> <p>*This character can expand into a team of up to 25 duplicate tabloid crew members.</p>	<p>Casual attire. Recording device (smartphone) as an optional prop – to capture potential stories!</p>
<p>MARS BRUNO Guitarist, Songwriter</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>Mars Bruno is a talented guitarist and songwriter. If you need a cheer-up, Turn to Mars for support and an open ear. Mars is the most dedicated friend you could have and is the best at problem-solving. Mars has frustrated the paparazzi because they have been unsuccessful at capturing any immoral or unethical behavior. In millions of fans' eyes – Mars does no wrong.</p>	<p>Casual attire and a guitar (real or fake) as an optional prop.</p>
<p>MACE FREELY Town Lunatic</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>Mace Freely is the antisocial town lunatic. As if Mace stepped out of a thirty-year cave of isolation, this town wanderer has no idea how to interact with others. Therefore, speaking with Mace is always unnerving and difficult. No one is immune to the uncomfortable stares and pauses during unwarranted conversations with this fruity loop.</p>	<p>Anything crazy. You have no concept of fashion or aesthetics.</p>

<p>AXON HUGGERS Poet</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>Axon Huggers is a morose, dark poet. Every sentence spewed from Axon's mouth is negative, unenthusiastic, and somewhat alarming. A self-proclaimed pessimist, Axon spends the days in a darkened dilapidated house writing sinister poetry. Axon is a popular choice as a host for televised celebrity roasts!</p>	<p>Trendy, dark-colored attire. Optional to bring dark poetry to be performed.</p>
<p>TAYLOR CYPRESS Pop Star</p> <p><i>Optional character</i></p>	<p>Taylor Cypress started out in the spotlight playing the role of a talented kid rock star called <i>Ali from Cali</i>. Lately, Taylor's gone off the deep end, and nobody knows what this star will do next.</p>	<p>Outrageous pop star attire.</p>

Expandable Teams: Some games (such as Sin City Slayer) may have expandable players. This is denoted in the description, the product details, and the character list. This means a specified player(s) is designed to have an optional team with them during the game. It's as if you were invited to a party and decided to bring along your friends/colleagues. What would you speak to the other guests about if you attended a party with your friend? You'd have a mutual acquaintance in common, so that's what you'd talk about!

In other words, if the character is a tabloid reporter (Reagan Paratsy), they can have a team of up to ~25+ tabloid crew members with them. The expandable team's cards will have the information/clues of their lead player, and that is what they use to play within the game.

The expandable players all have duplicate cards but are in the game just like everybody else otherwise. This is a great way to host large events and still give everyone a role in the game. If you are hosting a party for 100-200 people, you would not want 100-200 storylines to sift through once the mystery occurs. That's a nightmare. Expandable teams enable you to grow your guest list without adding chaos to your game while giving everyone the same type of materials to play the game.
