

HOST CHARACTER LIST – EXPANSION #2

CHARACTERS #31-38 (BOXED VERSION KIT C)

8 additional players, all optional and gender flexible.

It is best to play the expansion packs in order, as the characters are added to the lists in order. We do not advise you to skip expansion pack #1 with the download version.

These players may be played in any combo with any optional players from the main game and expansion pack #1

One character (Logan Mack) may be expanded into a team of duplicate TV show cast members (up to 25+). The download version comes with a file to download, and you are to make copies for each player on the team. For the boxed version (party pack), the expandable team with Logan Mack is only included in Kits E and F.

LOGAN MACK Children's Television Personality Optional character	Logan Mack is the lively lead monster character 'Spunky' on the children's television show <i>Monster Muggies</i> . The cast members are a loud, boisterous group who follow the direction of their leader, Logan Mack. *This character may be expanded into a team of up to 25 Monster Muggies cast members.	Monster costume of any kind.
DR. FUREN FEATHERS Veterinarian Optional character	Furen Feathers is the most annoying one-upper in Las Vegas. If you've done, said, or tried anything cool, Furen Feathers is sure to have done it more often, said it already, and tried it three times. This animal doctor is new to town, and only a few people truly know the real Dr. Feathers.	Lab jacket or scrubs. Optional to have a stethoscope and latex examination gloves.
PARKER TANKUS Guitarist Optional character	Parker Tankus is the rebellious guitarist for the band Tattered Toenails. Parker is highly critical of others and speaks without a filter. Rumors are circulating that Parker has driven a wedge through the band's morale, and the days of Tattered Toenails are numbered.	Skintight brightly colored leggings, rock t-shirt, glam rock hair & makeup. Optional to have a guitar (real or fake) as a prop.
REDD CROWNLY Dental Hygienist Optional character	Redd Crownly is the peculiar dental hygienist at <i>Vegas Dental</i> . A constant whistler, Redd Crownly will grace you with uncomfortable stares and periods of awkward silence during conversation.	Lab jacket or scrubs. A nametag with 'Vegas Dental' and new containers of dental floss, toothbrushes, etc., are optional.
REESE HARVEY Personal Trainer Optional character	Reese Harvey is a personal trainer at <i>The Vegas Sweat Center</i> . Reese loves to talk about one thing and one thing only – Reese Harvey. If this self-loving athlete isn't with a client, you'll find this gym rat playing video games or napping. Reese isn't known for having much ambition.	Workout attire. Optional to bring workout rubber bands and business cards for The Vegas Sweat Center.

DREW ADEL Social Media Consultant Optional character	Drew Adel is a highly intellectual social media consultant. A dependable, hard worker, Drew is a loyal friend. You will love to be around Drew as long as the constant hashtagging doesn't bother you. #reallyannoying #pleasestop	Casual attire (t-shirt, jeans). An optional prop is a smartphone with access to social media sites (e.g., X, Snapchat, etc.).
BUVIE GARRET Website Designer Optional character	Buvie Garret is a hardworking website designer. A superstar developer, Buvie has designed websites for most businesses in Las Vegas and a growing number of Hollywood elite. However, Buvie usually turns down clients who aren't rich and famous, which has given this website guru a snooty reputation.	Casual attire.
DAKOTA VAIL College Student Optional character	Dakota Vail is a nerdy math major at Las Vegas University. There isn't an equation this genius hasn't conquered - or created. Dakota spends countless hours at the library reading books about historical mathematicians. There isn't much Dakota cares about outside of numerical equations.	Casual, nerdy attire. Hair in a nerdy style (i.e., slick back, etc.). White socks, dark shoes, and optional to have a calculator

Expandable Teams: Some games (such as Sin City Slayer) may have expandable players. This is denoted in the description, the product details, and the character list. This means a specified player(s) is designed to have an optional team with them during the game. It's as if you were invited to a party and decided to bring along your friends/colleagues. What would you speak to the other guests about if you attended a party with your friend? You'd have a mutual acquaintance in common, so that's what you'd talk about!

In other words, with Logan Mack, if the character is a cast member on Monster Muggies TV show, they can have a team of up to \sim 25+ fellow cast members with them. The expandable team's cards will have the information/clues of their lead player, and that is what they use to play within the game.

The expandable players all have duplicate cards but are in the game just like everybody else otherwise. This is a great way to host large events and still give everyone a role in the game. If you are hosting a party for 100-200 people, you would not want 100-200 storylines to sift through once the mystery occurs. That's a nightmare. Expandable teams enable you to grow your guest list without adding chaos to your game while giving everyone the same type of materials to play the game.
