Remy narrates every interaction like a reality show confessional, complete with dramatic pauses, foreshadowing, and a signature side-eye at an imaginary camera. The algorithm fears Remy. This podcaster is known for pausing mid-sentence just long enough to make audiences lean in, only to hit them with a sudden twist.
