**following:** *I will say whatever I feel like saying to whomever I want - and nobody can boss me around or they won't like the outcome. Plus, you just look like somebody that would murder Santa Claus – get over yourself.*

**If anybody else contacts you, respond that you'll speak to them about it at the party.**



**ROUND ONE CARDS** each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

## **CHARACTER K – ROUND ONE**

### **CLUES TO REVEAL WHILE MINGLING WITH OTHER GUESTS:**

-  Confront \*name removed\* about this lawsuit that you were served papers for recently. You will murder \*name removed\* if she doesn't drop this lawsuit immediately.
-  Tell \*name removed\* that if s/he calls the city on you for having grass that's taller than allowed, you will murder \*name removed\*. You are tired of having such a horrible neighbor.
-  Tell \*name removed\* that you are well aware that s/he was feuding with Santa Claus (\*name removed\*) over their late great grandfather's inheritance. You joked around and told Santa that he should just hire a mobster to assassinate \*name removed\* so Santa could get all the money and make all of the updates to the toy factory that he wanted to do. There's no sense in holding up a huge inheritance in the courts.

### **CLUES THAT YOU MAY CONCEAL IF YOU WISH**

-  You do not want to talk about the murder of Santa Claus. It is negative, and you'd rather stay positive. Evade all questions involving the crime.
-  You are blackmailing \*name removed\*. You saw her with \*name removed\* with a briefcase full of cash. She pays you 1K per week for you to stay quiet. She claimed she was paying him to change residential zones to commercial zones.

**ROUND TWO CARDS** each player will have one in the printable file. Character names removed to minimize spoilers. You are cautioned to read this if you are trying to keep everything a surprise, but it will give you an idea of some storylines.

## **CHARACTER L – ROUND TWO**

### **PRE-MURDER CLUES:**

- 📄 Somebody is being blackmailed here – find out who and why.
- 📄 One day, you were bored and tried to get into *Winter Wonderland Amusement Park* for free by jumping the fence by the *Nightmare of Christmas* ride that \*name removed\* runs. \*Name removed\* spotted you and immediately called security and had you thrown out of the park and banned for life. You thought \*name removed\* was your friend!
- 📄 Tell a few people that you are not sorry that Santa is gone. You were angry at him for not giving you a job. He told your auntie that you were lazy and too tall, and that's why you didn't get the job you applied for in *Santa's Workshop*. You still say it is discrimination! Lazy people need jobs too!

### **POST-MURDER CLUES:**

- ☠️ There are clues here for the murder.
- ☠️ Each player will have 3-5 clues to share during the post-murder investigation round.

**ROUND 3 SOLUTION CARDS – there will be one for each player.**

The solution is given here. Each player will present a solution to the group and the murderer will confess.
